Regular plurals (rules)

One or more than one?

- **Add -s or -es:** *computer-computers, match-matches, dish-dishes, bus-buses, box-boxes, potato-potatoes*
- **Consonant + y --- ies:** *family-families*
- **f/ fe --- ves:** *shelf-shelves, life-lives*

Pronunciation of –s and –es:

<i>/s/</i>	<i>/z/</i>	<i>/ɪz/</i>
Visits	Friends	Places
Forts	Castles	Changes
Sites	Teams	Buses

Irregular plurals

A mouse or two mice?

- **Change vowel, ending or whole word:** *man-men, woman-women, child-children, person-people, tooth-teeth, foot-feet, goose-geese, mouse-mice, louse-lice*
- **No change:** *fish-fish, deer-deer, sheep-sheep, series-series, species-species*
- **Latin endings:** *phenomenon-phenomena, datum-data, thesis-theses, appendix-appendices*

Suffixes

The enlargement of words

-dom: *wisdom, kingdom...*

-ity: *quality, necessity...*

-ment: *argument, agreement...*

-sion/-tion: *television, information...*

-ness: *happiness, Scottishness...*

-ance/-ence: *appearance, difference...*

-er/-or: *teacher, visitor...*

-ist: *scientist, pianist...*
