Types of infinitives and gerunds

• They are so happy to see each other! (infinitive used after certain adjectives)

Resumen

- He would like to know more about it. (infinitive used after certain verbs)
- Students take important exams to get their GCSE. (infinitive used to express purpose)

- He's very interested in learning about Spain. (gerund used after a preposition)
- Paco enjoys listening to Paul. (gerund used after certain verbs)
- Attending school is compulsory up to the age of 16. (gerund used as a noun, as the subject of the sentence)





Verbs followed by infinitives and gerunds

- Followed by infinitives: *want, hope, intend, decide, fail, hope, learn, plan, refuse, try, deserve, need…*
- Followed by gerunds: enjoy, recommend...
- Objects before the infinitive: *allow, warn, advise...*
- Gerund or infinitive with change of meaning: *He stopped smoking. He stopped to smoke.*
