Changes in reported speech

'You can use a cable car' said Paco.

| DIRECT | REPORTED |

| SPEECH | SPEECH |
| •Quotation marks. •Original words at the beginning or at the end. •We can name the speaker at the beginning or at the end. •Jennifer said = said Jennifer •NOT POSSIBLE: *said he | •We don't use quotation marks. •We use 'that' after the reporting verb. •Verb: one step back. •Changes in personal pronouns and references to time or place. |
