IF + PRESENT SIMPLE, WILL/WON'T + INFINITIVE





First conditional sentences

I'll go unless you tell me to stay

If I study (CONDITION), I will pass my exams(RESULT). I will pass my exams(RESULT) if I study(CONDITION).

I'll go unless you tell me to stay.

=

I'll go if you don't tell me to stay.

(UNLESS= IF NOT)





Would

Adam would love to visit the Guinness Storehouse

If they lived in Ireland, they **would** celebrate St. Patrick's every year. **CONDITIONAL SENTENCES**

I would like to have a lie-in. EXPRESSING PREFERENCES

He **would** always tell me how much he missed Ireland.

REPETITION IN THE PAST

I told him I would visit Ireland one day. PAST OF 'WILL'

Would you mind meeting in the afternoon? POLITE REQUESTS
