SUPERIORITY

To say that people, things, etc. are superior to another in a particular way, we often use the structure

-er/more ... (adjective in the comparative degree/adverb)... than

E.g. Paco's clothes are **more casual than** Andrés's Andrés is **taller than** Paco Does Paco play tennis **better than** Andrés? The UK isn't a **hotter country than** South Africa

We can also compare nouns:

E.g. Andrés's sister earns **more money than** her brother
