Passive voice with modal verbs THE SAME STRUCTURE

- The 'Big Five' can be found here.
- A great variety of animals can be contemplated here.
- Some hippos might be found too.
- Animals can't be fed.
- Packed means would be prepared.





Some sentences can't be made passive

- Intransitive verbs: He stayed in the hotel.
- Verb 'have': Paco has a new camera.
- Verb 'resemble': Paco resembles his father.
- Verbs with a reflexive pronoun as object: *The little boy dressed himself.*
